## Strategy

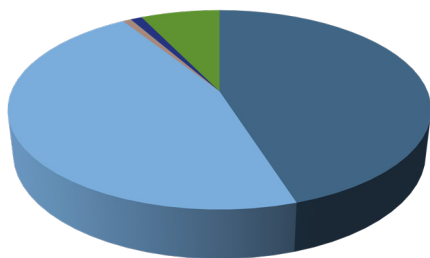

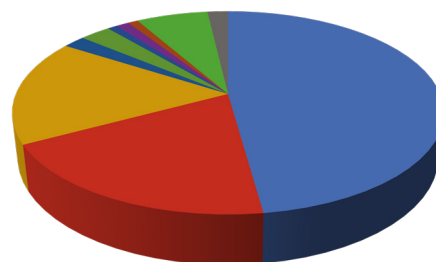
